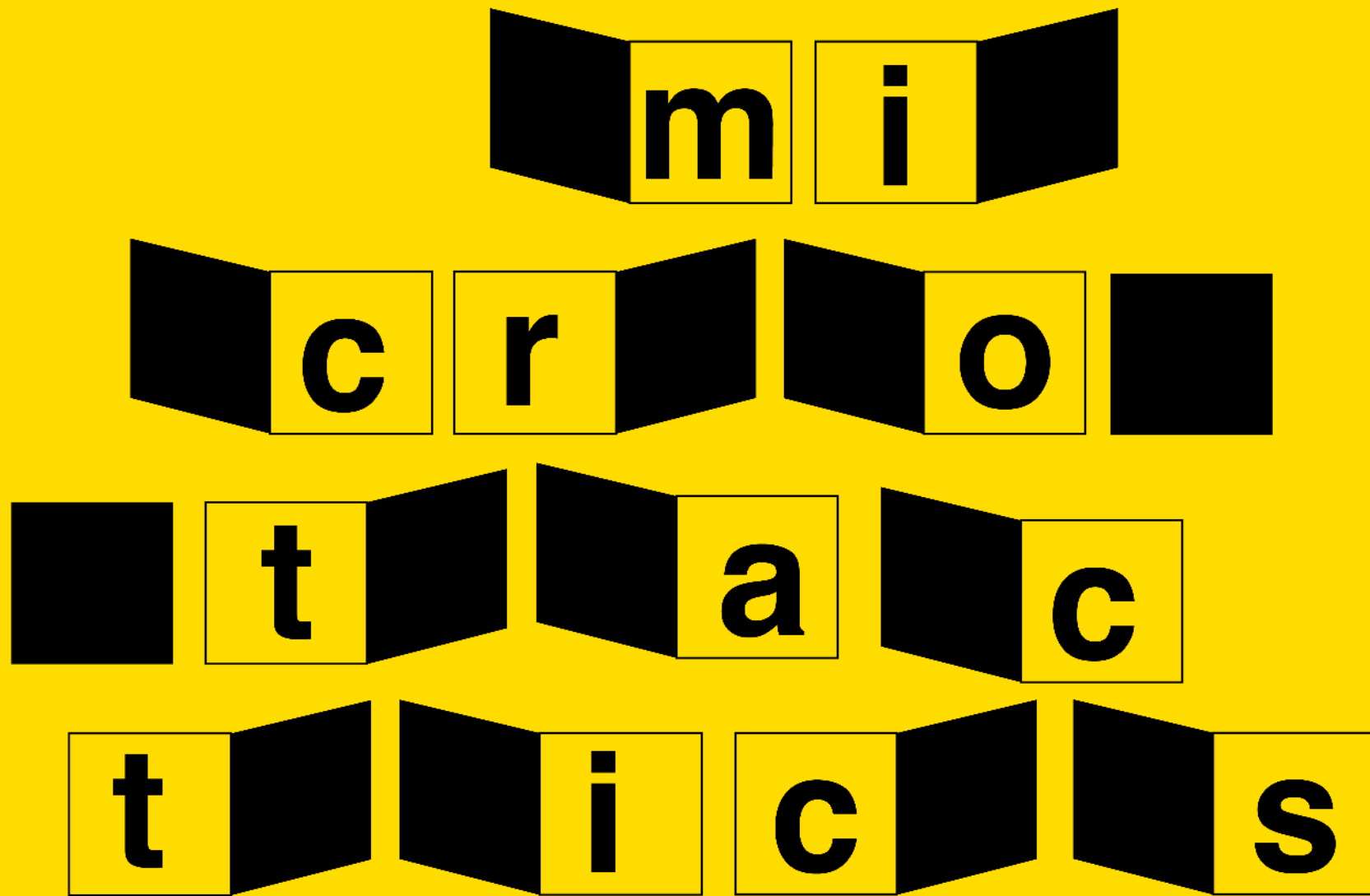

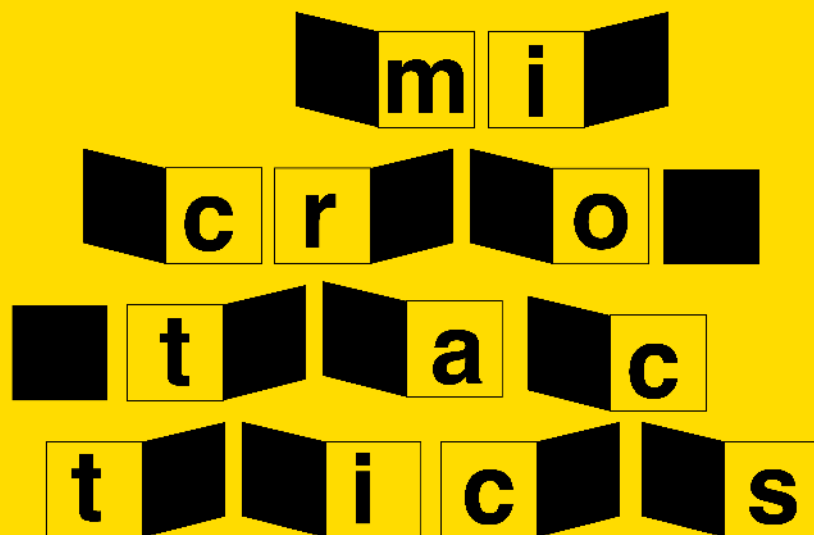

Join us and explore how these seemingly fragmented approaches can be harnessed to drive larger societal change.

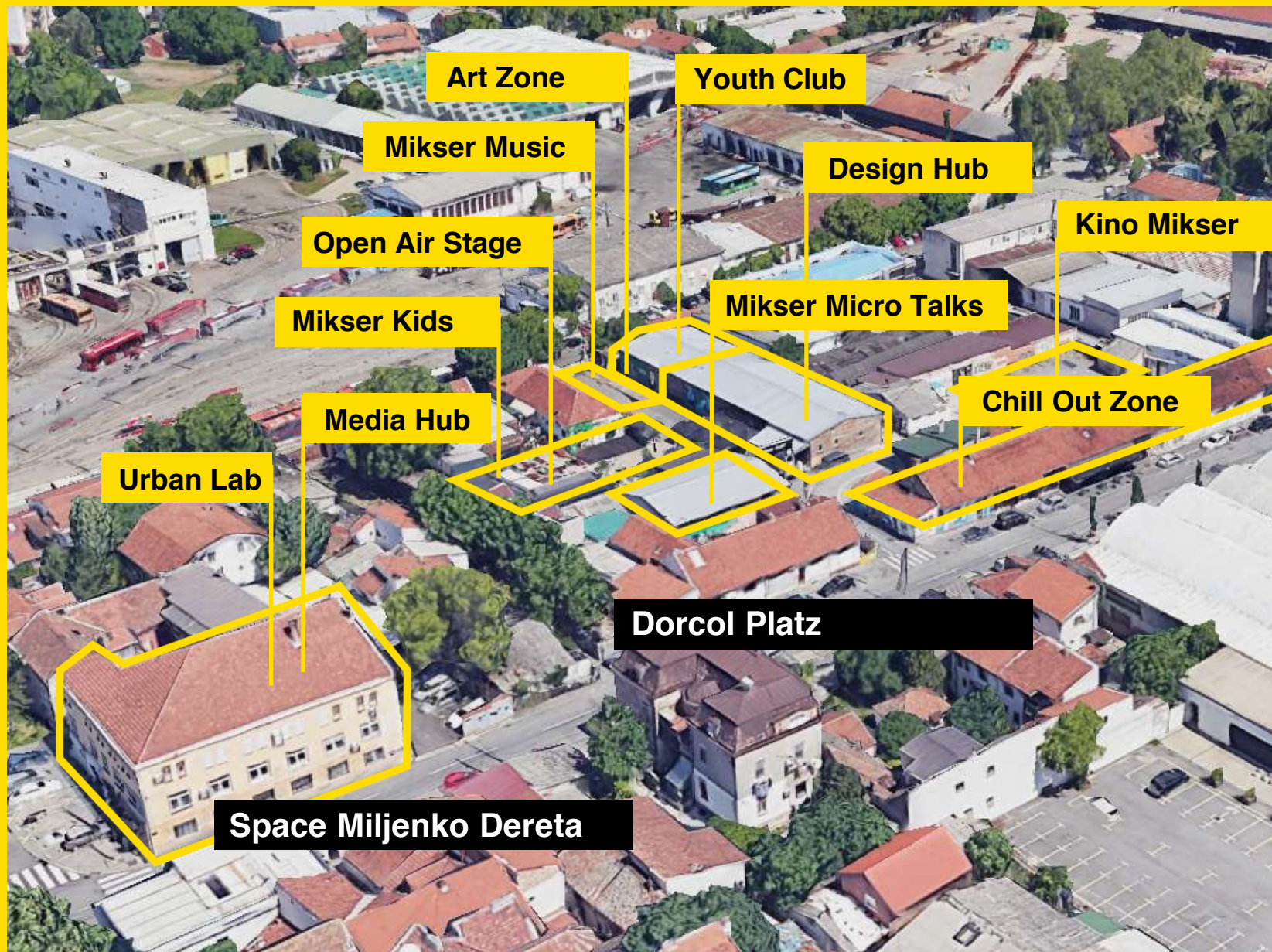

Initially conceived as a platform for the presentation of unrealized ideas of the latest generation of Serbian designers, **Ghost Project** gained international recognition and grew into a continuous endeavour – a dynamic database of international young design talents. During more than 15 years since its initial edition at the Belgrade Design Week, the Ghost Project platform has so far presented more than 600 designers and their innovative ideas.

ART ZONE

The backbone of the Mikser Festival Art zone is the platform “Black Box” initiated in 2015 in a cooperation with the Faculty of Applied Arts in Belgrade to support young authors to experiment with the multidisciplinary approach. The aim of the project is to reflect intimate and social topics that preoccupy young creators, to empower them to express themselves artistically in public space and contribute to the public debate on societal changes with their visions.

Six editions of the Black Box exhibition has so far presented more than 400 young authors from diverse creative fields and facilitated their dialogue with prominent regional art figures through series of art talks, workshops and Q&A's.

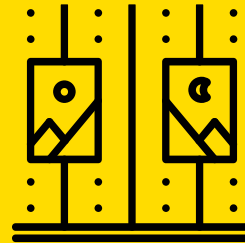
Reusable plastic cups

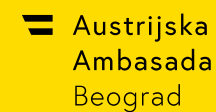
